Judith Lowe – 28th February 2008 **The Farther Reaches of New Code NLP -**



'New Code NLP' was originally developed by John Grinder and Judith DeLozier in the late 80's as a way of shifting the focus of NLP to the *interactions* and *relationships* between elements in living systems, placing greater emphasis

on community, wisdom, artistry and art, mind-body connection and living in harmony with self and others.

Judith will lead us on a journey into the farther reaches and applications of New Code which will take us to **'states'** – especially high performance states, **'conscious/unconscious relationships'** –to support congruence, unconscious competence, refined intuition and wisdom in resourceful living, **'perceptual positions'**, **'multiple description'** - the ability to form and hold different mental 'maps' of a situation and **'perceptual filters'** – increasing our ability to take in information from the world.

Judith has been working with NLP for twenty years and is the Managing Director of PPD Learning Ltd. She is an engaging trainer, who is deeply

committed to having NLP make a contribution at the highest levels of human thinking and action.

Charles Faulkner – 5th June 2008 **The Language of Our Bodies –** **A New Linguistics for NLP**

There is a body in our minds, an embodied consciousness that organizes all of our experience in our everyday words, gestures and inner representations.

Created from the research of leading cognitive scientists and linguists, Charles will present a new linguistics for NLP grounded in our bodily experience - an actual somatic syntax found in the elements of our everyday experience, syntax that makes submodalities a coherent system, all Sleight-of-Mouth Patterns just 3 simple moves, and explains change as simple emergent properties of meaning making across the depth and breadth of our lives. This will be a physical as well as mental session, so bring all of yourself and be ready for a change.



Charles Faulkner is an original NLP modeller, innovator, trainer and author who made early applications in *NLP: The New Technology of Achievement, Success Mastery, and The Essence of Intuition* and has created new models including *Metaphors of Identity* and *Irresistible Influence*. A passionate researcher of all things human, Charles tells stories, engages in dialogue and creates a pattern that connects. Long time colleague of Steve and Connirae Andreas, he is the Director of Programmes for NLP Comprehensive in the United States.

Marie Faire - 28th August 2008 False Evidence Appearing Real

We know from NLP that The Map is not the Territory. One of the greatest distortions of the Maps we create occurs when we allow fear to become our master instead of our servant. As one poem puts it,

"the regrets of yesterday and the fear of tomorrow rob us of today".



In this Masterclass Marie will utilise various NLP techniques and models and draw upon the work of David Richo, Susan Jeffers, Dorothy Rowe and others plus her own experience over the last twenty five years to explore some of the core fear patterns that drive our behaviour in everyday life.

The proposition for this Masterclass is that, at our core we fear not being love worthy and this manifests itself as the fear of engulfment and the fear of abandonment. If we are to free ourselves and have the sort of relationships and lives we want and deserve we need to engage with those fears and understand them; transform them when they don't serve us and be grateful for them when they do.

Marie Faire is co-founder and a Director of The Beyond Partnership, and is lead trainer on our NLP Master Practitioner and Trainer Training. She has a MA in Management Learning and extensive training in humanistic psychology and group dynamics; she lists among her interests New Physics, scuba diving and learning just about anything!

Sue Knight - 27th November 2008 Provocative Coaching - Hold on to Your Hats



The ability to stand back and laugh at oneself has to be one of the surest ways of cutting through the web of tangled myths that we create for ourselves. Something happens in our brains when we laugh. Change occurs. We hotwire the engine in our mind, that

has become stuck with too much serious deliberation, to the source of energy that can spark us into life again.

Drawing on the Provocative Therapy work of Frank Farrelly with whom she has been associated for 14 years, Sue will present a provocative approach to coaching and initiating change. In this approach warm-hearted humour in its varied forms - exaggeration, irony, self-deprecation, Daliesque absurdities etc., is one of the main tools to implement change. Frank Farrelly was one of the early therapists to be modelled by Bandler and Grinder as they recognised in him an outstanding ability to take people to that place of "truth", get them to laugh at it and at themselves, and find more freedom.

Sue Knight is author of the best selling *NLP at Work*. She is a business consultant and NLP trainer. Sue divides her time mainly between the UK, India and France where she and her husband have a home. She loves cycling and dancing and she does a mean Quickstep and Cha Cha!!
